

FBI Raids La Mirada Home Connected in Credit Card Fraud Ring; Arrests Made Throughout Area

La Mirada~Authorities served a federal warrant on a home in La Mirada this morning in connection with an alleged credit card fraud ring and methamphetamine distribution operation.

Shortly after 6:00 Tuesday morning, residents told us they heard a loud boom as authorities used a flash-bang device to gain access to the home located in the 13800 block of Mansa Drive.

Agencies involved in the raid included the California Highway Patrol, Huntington Beach Police Department and the FBI as we [first reported at 6:41 a.m.](#) local time on our Twitter feed with exclusive photos and video.

Other arrest and search warrants were served in the southeast cities area in connection with the scam as reported by [KTLA](#) and the [Cerritos Patch](#) .

The La Mirada residents indicted in the case are still at-large at last report.
